Classes

Class 1. 'Mythical Forest'

A Petite (Small scale design) Exhibit, 25cms Width x 25cms Depth x 37cms Height. On tiered tabling covered in black fabric.

Class 2. 'Natures Contrast'

A Novice Exhibit, 60cms Width x 76cms Depth, Height optional. On tabling covered in black fabric against a white wall. Open to anyone who has not won a first prize at a NAFAS or RHS show.

Class 3. 'When All the Colours Come a Dancing'

A Pedestal Exhibit, space allowed 120cms Width x 120cms Depth, height optional. Staged on beige/ cream floor tiles against a grey fabric screen approx. 2 m in height. Competitor to provide own pedestal.

Class 4. 'Twigs and Cones'

An Exhibit 75cms Width x 75cms Depth, Height optional. on open tabling covered in black fabric. To be viewed and judged from the front.

Class 5. 'Once Upon a Mushroom'

A Craft Exhibit 40cms Width x 40cms Depth x 40cms Height. Plant material must predominate. On open tabling covered in black fabric. To be viewed and judged from the front.

Class 6. 'Full Ripe and Fruity'

A Still Life Exhibit, 90cms Width x 76cms Depth, Height Optional. On open tabling covered with black fabric. To be viewed all round and judged from the front

Class 7. 'Untamed Beauty'

An Exhibit 90cms Width x 76cms Depth, Height Optional. On open tabling covered in black fabric, to be viewed all round but judged from the front.

Class 8. "Strange and Beautiful"

100cms Width x 100cms Depth Height Optional to be staged on beige/stone floor in front mainly of glass windows. To be viewed and judged from the front.

NB: TO COMPLY WITH RHS RULES NO FLORAL FOAM IS ALLOWED IN ANY EXHIBIT BUT AGRI-WOOL & TERRA BRICK ARE ACCEPTABLE. BUXUS IS PROHIBITED ON SITE AND ROSES FROM NORTH AMERICA OR INDIA WILL NOT BE PERMITTED

NOTES

- To be judged according to NAFAS competition rules.
- Competitive classes are open to all.
- Pre-done work is acceptable in all classes.
- To be staged in the Garden Room at RHS Rosemoor, access for exhibitors through the rear door from the staff car park. You will be required to move your car to the car park after off-loading.
- Entry is free to the Garden Room but should you want to look around the garden, you may be asked to pay.
- Staging times, 8.30 am – 1.30 pm on Thursday 14th August 2025.
- Judging 2.00 pm. The judge's decision is final.
- Water sources for your exhibit, any flowers or foliage that are not in good condition will be removed from the exhibit.
- **Please leave your watering instructions with a member of the committee if you wish to have your exhibit watered.**
- **Parking permits must be displayed in the car front window before entering Rosemoor to get you to the right car park.**
- All entries will be accepted in strict rotation until classes are full.
- Natural plant material must predominate in all exhibits.
- **Bearing in mind the overall title, preference should be given to plant material that can be grown in UK gardens.**
- Artificial plant material is NOT ALLOWED.
- No spray paints to be used in the building.
- Small prizes will be given by the RHS, prize-giving will be at 3.30 pm on Sunday 17th August.
- Take down will be from 4.00 pm on Sunday, 17th August
- Exhibitors' own bases and backgrounds may always be used.
- Neither the RHS nor NAFAS takes responsibility for personal injury or loss.
- Please inform the Show Secretary immediately if you are unable to stage your exhibit.

- The NAFAS Competitions Manual, if required, can be obtained from www.nafas.org.uk for the price of £5.
- Entering the competition is giving permission for photographs of your exhibit taken by official RHS and NAFAS photographers, possibly being used in future publications.
